## PNB LBO Selection Process 2025

The selection process for PNB LBO 2025 consists of four stages:

2. Screening: Shortlisting based on eligibility and written test marks.
3. Language Proficiency Test (LPT): Candidates must demonstrate proficiency in the local language of the state for which they have applied.

4. Personal Interview: Final round to evaluate communication and professional aptitude. The final merit list is prepared based on the combined performance in the written test and interview, subject to qualifying in the LPT.
